

PhD Preliminary Exam Approval Form

(Submit to the Graduate Coordinator at least three weeks before exam)

The preliminary examination may be taken only after: approval of the PhD minor/graduate certificate; passing the qualifying exam; completion of at least 32 graduate-level UW courses in residency; and with at least two semesters remaining prior to graduation. This oral examination is based upon a written proposal and a detailed plan to carry out the Ph.D. dissertation. Students must consult with their advisor for specific details of the requirements for the preliminary examination. Students must comply with the Graduate School minimum requirements as well as the department requirements in order to be considered for dissertation status.
