Requirements

- At least 9 credits of ECE coursework 400 level or above
 - 3 Credits must be ECE course 700 level or above
- B or better in all courses used for minor
- At most 1 course can be cross listed with student's major department if taught by ECE faculty
- Only 3 credits of prior (transferred) graduate coursework can be used to satisfy minor requirements

ECE Doctoral Minor

PhD students from other UW-Madison graduate programs who wish to earn a minor in ECE are required to complete a minimum of nine credits of ECE courses numbered 400-level or above. At least three of these nine credits must be earned in courses numbered 700-level or above. Students must earn a B or better in all courses used for the minor. At most, one course cross-listed with the student's major department may be counted toward the minor requirement, provided the course was taught by a faculty member whose primary affiliation is ECE. Students minoring in ECE can transfer up to 3 credits of prior graduate coursework toward the 9-credit requirement with course equivalency approval. Approval of the courses for the Option A ECE Doctoral minor for non-ECE students is certified by the ECE Graduate Committee. In order to obtain minor approval from the ECE Department, students must complete this form, get it signed by their faculty advisor, and return the form to the ECE Graduate Coordinator.

Transferring Coursework

To transfer ECE coursework, you will fill out a course [equivalency form](#). If you are transferring multiple courses, you will need to fill out a form for each course.

Please create a Box or Google folder for each course you are transferring because multiple pieces of information are needed for **each** course.

- Copy of transcript with the course taken outside of UW-Madison highlighted
- Copy of the official syllabus for the course taken outside of UW-Madison (if printed from the web, be sure to highlight the URL)
- Copy of official catalog description for the course taken outside of UW-Madison (if printed from the web, be sure to highlight the URL)
- Title of Textbook and Author for the course taken outside of UW-Madison
- ***If your request is complex or any of the above is missing for a course, please include a letter of explanation with the course equivalency request.***
