- This form is for Department of Mechanical Engineering Graduate Students to request to use credits earned from a UW-Madison undergraduate program in a UW-Madison Mechanical Engineering/Engineering Mechanics graduate program.
- No more than 7 undergraduate credits (generally 2 courses) may be used in the graduate program. Splitting course credits is not permitted. Review your program policies in your handbook to learn what courses/credits are permissible, with faculty advisor approval. **Courses must have been earned LESS than 10 years prior to matriculation for use in the PhD program.**

- Credits earned in the undergraduate program and permitted to count in the graduate program will not: be part of the graduate GPA, satisfy graduate residency requirements, or satisfy the Graduate School Minimum Graduate Coursework (50%) requirement (unless the course was 700+ level).
- The undergraduate credits permitted for use in the graduate program may satisfy appropriate specific curricular credit requirements including total credits required for the degree, with advisor approval.
